**Teresa Storch Band** grew organically from the meeting of (now husband and wife) Teresa Storch and Peter Lacis. Storch's soulful voice and lyrics combine with Lacis' soaring and complex guitar arrangements. Grounded in the band's tight arrangements and freewheeling improvisation, they interweave pop, rock, and jam, with influences from Emmylou Harris to the Allman Brothers and call their approach **Jamericana**. Their 2024 release, *Open Your Heart*, is a social and political body of work, revealing a woman attuned to the world and its discontents—reckoning with the #metoo movement, searching for optimism in the Trump era and recovering from a dysregulating pandemic. The band performs regularly across the Colorado Front Range at clubs and festivals such as the Boulder Creek Festival.
